POLICE BLOTTER

Updated March 1, 2013

The police blotter primarily reports arrests. It may also contain information on public alerts or ongoing investigations. All are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a Court of Law.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: WARRANT ARREST

February 4, 2013 3:45 pm

P.O. V. Migliorino arrested an 18 year old male Moonachie resident on a warrant issued by the Garfield Municipal Court for Terroristic Threats alleged in that City. He was processed at Moonachie Police Headquarters and turned over to the Garfield Police Department.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: ELUDING POLICE, RESISTING ARREST

February 14, 2013 12:28 am

A report over the State Police Emergency Network radio reported a vehicle had attempted to ram into an Englewood Cliff's Police Officer's vehicle during an earlier pursuit in that borough. P.O. V. Migliorino and P.O. C. Inserra located the vehicle traveling Route 46 westbound in Teterboro. P.O. Inserra attempted to initiate a motor vehicle stop when the vehicle fled at a high rate of speed. P.O. Inserra and P.O. Migliorino pursued the vehicle through local streets in Hasbrouck Heights and into Lodi where the driver stopped the car and attempted to flee on foot. Following a foot pursuit the accused was apprehended after attempting to hide in the yard of a local property. He was arrested on numerous outstanding warrants and charged with Eluding Police, Resisting Arrest, and Assault on a Police Officer.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED

February 19, 2013 09:46 pm

P.O. M. Rose arrested a 60 year old female Clark, NJ resident for Driving While Intoxicated on Moonachie Road following a motor vehicle stop. The accused was transported Hackensack University Medical Center where blood was drawn for B.A.C. analysis. She was released on summonses.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: AGGRAVATED ASSAULT**February 23, 2013 7:07 am**

P.O. S. Lemongello and P.O. V. Migliorino arrested a 30 year old Moonachie resident for hitting another man in the head with a large concrete block. The victim was transported to the hospital. The accused was processed at police headquarters and released on summonses.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: ASSAULT ON POLICE OFFICER, RESISTING ARREST**February 24, 2013 8:18 pm**

P.O. C. Inserra and P.O. R. Pezzillo were dispatched to the area of Joseph Street on a report of a suspicious male party knocking on doors. Upon arrival they located the accused that had refused to cooperate or provide any identification. After attempting to peacefully escort the accused from a local property the accused became combative and began to fight with the officers. The accused, P.O. Inserra and P.O. Pezzillo sustained minor injuries during the altercation. All were brought to Hackensack University Medical Center for treatment. The accused was treated and then transported to the Bergen County Jail. He was charged with Assault on a Police Officer and Resisting Arrest. Bail was set at \$15,000.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED, MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH ARREST**February 25, 2013, 10:17 pm**

P.O. V. Detrizio arrested a 32 year old Hasbrouck Heights resident for driving while intoxicated and reckless driving. While on routine patrol P.O. V. Detrizio discovered his vehicle had left the roadway on West Commercial Avenue. Upon further investigation it was determined the male had been intoxicated. Due to the severity of the motor vehicle crash and apparent level of intoxication the accused was transported to Hackensack University Medical Center for treatment and blood was drawn for B.A.C. analysis. He was released from the hospital on summonses.

INCIDENT / CHARGE: DISORDERLY CONDUCT ARREST**February 26, 2013 9:24 pm**

Sgt. T. Schmidt and P.O. V. Migliorino arrested a 27 year old Moonachie resident for Disorderly Conduct after he was warned numerous times to stop yelling in the street and acting in a threatening manner towards the officers. The officer's were speaking with the accused, who was intoxicated, after receiving reports that he may have been involved in a motor vehicle crash, hit and run, moments earlier. He was processed at police headquarters and released on a summons.
